## **Executive Summary**

This Labor Migration report is a bi-annual publication developed by the Boulder Regional Business Partnership (BRBP). It is designed to track commuting patterns for employees in the municipalities of Boulder County and the City and County of Broomfield. Information from the report has several uses including the impacts to transportation infrastructure, the extent to which communities are considered stand alone vs. bedroom, potential sales tax implications, jobs/housing balance and other public policy considerations. Private sector companies can also determine the origination of their labor force. Tracking this information over time also allows us to determine trends in commuting patterns that serve as indicators on how the local workforce availability is changing.

The Boulder Regional Business Partnership is a consortium of Chamber of Commerce and Economic Development agencies from Boulder and Broomfield Counties. Their purpose is to share information, coordinate activities and represent the business and government interests of their respective communities and the Counties as a whole.

The BRBP would like to recognize Wendi Nafziger, Vice President of the Longmont Area Economic Council, for her leadership efforts in coordinating this study and compiling its results.

The following is a brief synopsis of the results of this study for each of the communities involved. Specific details for each of the communities are included in the pages that follow.

### **Boulder/Broomfield Counties in Total**

- Lafayette, Longmont and Louisville all had a decrease in local participation over 2008. As a whole, the percentage of residents working and living in Boulder and Broomfield Counties decreased for the first time, but only slightly.
- Resident workforce declined for the first time in several years in Longmont.
- The city of Boulder was the only municipality to see appreciable gain in resident workforce in 2010.
- Lafayette showed the biggest decline as less than 10% of residents work locally.
- Metro Denver workforce continued its decline within the counties (22.5% in 2010).
- Workforce living and working in Boulder County in the public sector has declined each of the last four years: 65%, 64%, 59%, and 53%.

## **City of Boulder**

- The percentage of local workforce participation in Boulder increased overall from 2008 by 4.07%. It should be noted that while the resident participation rate for private sector jobs increased significantly (up from 20.81% to 30.82%), public sector participation decreased by about the same percentage from 41.39% to 35% (down 6.39%).
- Longmont continues to be the largest supplier of workforce, outside of the city of Boulder, to their labor market.
- Public sector job participation has decreased each year since 2004.
- Participation by Larimer/Weld County employees in the public sector increased from 4.69% in 2008 to 11.22% in 2010.

## **Broomfield**

- Broomfield again saw a decrease in the overall number of positions surveyed while their percentage of local workforce participation increased only slightly by 2.58%. Boulder County resident participation again decreased in 2010 as well as metro Denver residents.
- Broomfield's resident participation rate is 53.27% for public sector jobs, while the private sector jobs only reflect a 19.06% local participation rate. Metro Denver continues to be the strongest participant in the workforce of Broomfield with 54.05%. The community of Denver has nearly the same number of employees working in Broomfield as Broomfield itself.

## **Erie**

- Erie positions represent less than 0.1% of the total jobs surveyed in this report and are not statistically significant. However, local residents continue to hold the highest percentage of local jobs (40.23%) than any other area. Public sector jobs were surveyed in 2010 and represent more than double the number of Erie residents versus private sector (51.59% public versus 24.59% private).
- Private sector participation of Erie residents decreased from 34.29% in 2008 to 24.59% in 2010.
- Denver has the second highest number of employees working in Erie.

## **Lafayette**

- Lafayette's overall participation rate decreased by 5.74% in 2010.
- Boulder County (excluding Lafayette) participation went up in the private sector (4.5%), while Larimer/Weld Counties and Metro Denver increased in the public sector participation.

## **Longmont**

- More private sector residents from Larimer/Weld Counties work in Longmont than local residents for the first time in our surveying history.
- Local participation has declined for the first time since 2004 – the private sector by 10% and public sector by 9%.
- Larimer/Weld Counties continue to grow as percentage of the total workforce.
- More than twice as many employees commute from Larimer/Weld Counties to Longmont than those in Boulder County (excluding Longmont).
- After Longmont, the city of Boulder has the highest number of residents working in its workforce.
- Longmont continues to lead the other communities in Boulder and Broomfield Counties with more jobs held by local residents (38.70% versus the next highest percentage – Boulder at 33.39%).

## **Louisville**

- Louisville saw a slight decrease in the positions surveyed predominately in the public sector, as data was not available from the City of Louisville. The public sector decreased in resident participation over 2008 from 26.76% to 16.29%. This was the first year since 2002 that Louisville saw a decrease in total participation.
- Metro Denver residents continue to hold the largest percentage of jobs in Louisville at 32.99%, while Boulder County residents (not including Louisville) were a close second with 32.92%.
- Louisville has less than 13% of their population working and living in their community.

## **Superior**

- Superior saw a small increase in their participation rate from 15.04% to 15.47%. Positions surveyed represent less than 1% of the total jobs surveyed in this analysis.
- Metro Denver residents continue to hold the largest percentage of jobs in Superior with 48.00%. The number of Boulder County (not including Superior) residents decreased significantly from 16.71% to 9.87%.
